February has several holidays, a couple of presidents and of course Valentines Day. Start and finish a painting in one day. With red white and blue and chocolates there should be lots of mini displays to paint. Citrus trees might be blooming in the valley to brighten up the winter weather. And we will have some dishes and vases and fabric to add to our display. If you like bring an item or two from home. Come paint one or two items or all of the display if you are quick. There should be enough time to paint an 8" X 10".

We will start by sketching our composition on the canvas. Then we will put in the darks and shadows. We will work from dark to light and the last stroke is the highlight on our focal point. I'll help you gauge your time so that you will finish on time. This should be a fun time to explore something new or paint with friends.

Teaching Artist: Laurie Moore, my BA is in Art History and Ceramics. I lived in Southeast Asia for a number of years and when I returned I needed a new direction in my life. Since receiving my Masters of Fine Arts from the Academy of Art University in 2002, I have been doing mostly "en plein-air" painting, which is French for outdoors.
